Important Notes

Option A is a 42 hour major, requires 15 hours in two languages at the appropriate level, MLNG 459, and 9 additional hours in Linguistics and or Comparative Literatures and or additional upper division language 1 or 2 coursework. **A second major or minor is not required for Option A.**

Option B is a 27 hour major, requires 12 hours in two languages at the appropriate level, and MLNG 459 - **ALSO - A second major or minor is required for Option B**. Students should substitute second major or minor requirements in the "Elective Any Level" spaces on the degree plan. **Grade of "C" or higher is required.**

The Arabic, Chinese, Japanese, Navajo, Sign languages apply to major starting at the 2000 level (Level III).

The French, German, Greek, Italian, Latin, Portuguese, Russian, Spanish languages apply to the major starting at the 300/400 level.
