## Major Requirements

- \* 12 credits of Language. Roadmap has Balanced Spanish and Portuguese. See catalog for other options.
- \* 9 credits of Core, HIST1170, HIST1180, and LTAM360
- \* 12 credits of approved Area of Specialization. See below and catalog for list of areas.
- \* 3 credits of elective of any approved course.
- \* 18 credits of must be 300-level or above
- \* Capstone paper required from an upper division course, preferably LTAM360
- \* Courses from 3 different disciplines in Core, Area, and Electives (i.e. History, LTAM, POLS)
- \* Study abroad to Latin America or Spain is not required but highly encouraged
- \* Courses are approved every semester

*The Latin American Studies major is customized to every student's goals and interests. Therefore it is not recommended that this roadmap is used by students on their own. Advisement is REQUIRED for student success in this program.*
