## Important Notes

Students cannot simply "declare" Signed Language Interpreting. Admission to the Signed Language Interpreting Program is competitive and by application.

Application packets are reviewed each May. Students must complete SIGN 2125, 2210, and 2130, math, and writing and speaking before applying. \*It is strongly encouraged to apply as soon as these pre-requisites are completed\*

Transfer credit for previous ASL courses awarded on a case by case basis, based on evaluation of course, and the skills of the student

Students who wish to fulfill their undergraduate second language requirement by taking American Sign Language should be aware that because of the high demand for ASL classes and limited seating, we cannot guarantee enrollment
