## Important Notes

Degree plan is setup with a 2nd major for number of classes that might be needed in a 2nd major or 2 minors  
Math 1350 is the gen ed math needed for Sociology. No other gen ed math accepted as a pre-req in the major  
There are a number of classes which meet the UNM diversity requirement and count towards the Sociology major. Ask your advisor for more details.  
A 2.25 GPA is needed for admission to Sociology.  
While Sociology offers two concentrations, human services and pre-law, no concentration is required.
