Arts & Sciences Scholarship Guidelines- updated March 2024

- All Arts & Sciences Scholarships with the exception of A&S success grants and the general Arts & Sciences scholarship, are endowed accounts that originate from the UNM Foundation.
- Official correspondence is sent to UNM email accounts and all questions/inquiries are to be routed to the Arts & Sciences Scholarship email asawards@unm.edu.
- Eligibility includes the following:
 - Declared Arts & Sciences Major
 - Enrollment is set at full-time status with a few exceptions. Medical exceptions are accepted through ARC (Accessibility Resources Center).
 - Financial Aid Criteria:
 - EFC (Estimated Family Contribution) is required for need based endowments.
 - UNM Financial aid information will suffice will merit-based scholarships
- The application period is in the spring semester (March-April) and aligns with the UNM Financial Aid Office's timeline for distributing the next academic year award information.
- All application material has to be submitted through infoready and the link will be made available once the application period is live on the website.
- Additional criteria for scholarship applications includes the following items:
 - Students are expected to submit UNM financial aid information, which requires the FAFSA or state aid link to be completed prior to applying for the A&S scholarships.
 - NM State financial aid pertains to students with an international status and often cannot complete a FAFSA. Please discuss these options with the UNM Financial Aid Office.
 - UNM Financial Aid award info needed for the scholarship applications in infoready can be found by following these steps:
 - Go To myunm.edu
 - Log in with your UNM Net ID and password
 - Click the Student Life Tab
 - Click on the red "Enter Lobo Web" button
 - Click on Financial Aid Tab
 - Click on AWARD INFO MENU
 - Click on AWARD PACKAGE FOR AID YEAR (The following

academic year- corresponding with the current application period in infoready).

- Select the current academic year from the SELECT AID YEAR list (click submit)
- Click on AWARD OVERVIEW (the need calculation and cost of attendance is available here).
- Letter(s) of recommendation from faculty members familiar with your academic performance. Typically, one letter is required for most endowments.
 - Exceptions:
 - Frank O. and Sadie M. Lane Scholarship- requires two letters of recommendation from faculty members only
 - Late Bloomer Scholarship- requires a letter of recommendation from a current or former employer.
- Letters of recommendation are only accepted from the following groups:

 faculty members or lecturers at UNM or other higher education institutions.
 **GA/TA/RA letters, advisors, internship directors etc, are accepted as an additional letter, only after a letter from a faculty member is obtained.
- The Dean's designee, the Associate Dean for Student Success, will oversee the scholarship selection process and direct the scholarship committee.
- Once selected for a scholarship, students will be notified through their UNM email.

A&S Scholars can expect the following, once selected for a scholarship.

- If selected for an A&S scholarship, students will maintain satisfactory academic performance as defined under the guidelines of the UNM Scholarship Office.
- Students will maintain the course load expected of them, depending on the endowment agreement, unless a sufficient explanation is submitted to the scholarship coordinator, which may include health/accessibility issues that require a doctor's note and/or explanation from the UNM Accessibility Resource Center.
- Once selected, A&S scholars will receive their funding for an entire academic year. This means the awards are divided between the fall and spring semesters unless otherwise stated.
 - Exception: Frank O. & Sadie M. Lane Endowed Scholarship. If scholars plan to graduate earlier (fall semester), they should contact the

scholarship coordinator to inform them of their updated graduation date.

- Scholarships are for undergraduate students seeking their first BA/BS degree. (Students seeking a 2nd BA/BS degree will not be considered).
- A&S General (Endowed) Scholarships are not offered for summer session unless otherwise noted. Exceptions would be the A&S Summer Success Grant, the C.T. French Scholarship and Chester French Stewart and Diana Stewart Scholarship (depending on available funding in each account).
- Students are expected to submit a thank you letter for the Academic Year endowments, to <u>asthankyou@unm.edu</u> no later than May 31 every academic year. Award forms will not be submitted to the financial aid office until thank you letters have been received. Summer endowment thank you letters must be submitted by the last week of May.
- Scholarships are renewable based on the student's academic progress and fund availability in the scholarship account. General policy has been to renew an award for up to 4 semesters unless otherwise stated. Not every scholarship is renewable; details will be included in the original award letter.

As stated on the scholarship form at time of application, the student grants permission to the College of Arts & Sciences to review their academic records in accordance with the UNM Scholarship Office. GPA and grade checks are reviewed periodically to ensure students are complying with maintaining satisfactory
